Stenbury Federation Sports Day 2022 – Friday 8th July

We are very excited to announce that the Stenbury Federation Sports Day 2022 will be held on Friday 8th July 2022 at Rookley Village Hall and Sports field Cricket club (PO38 3NJ). Rookley Parish Council have kindly given us full use of the amazing facilities in order to run a collaborative Sports Day for the Federation.

On the day, the children will be taken via mini bus to the venue in preparation for a 10.30am start. The activities will take place for all pupils, in class groups, simultaneously from 10.30am-11.45am Each class group will take part in multi skill based “field events,” such as speed bounce, javelin throw, football dribble and long jump. After the completion of the carousel of activities, the children will have a short break before taking part in a short distance sprint and a longer distance race around the track. Every child will therefore take part in eight events throughout the day.

Parents / family members are invited to come and watch their children participate as the enthusiasm and engagement from parents/family members really makes the day special. At the conclusion of the races, we will sit in class groups and have a picnic style lunch on the field (from 12:30 until 1:00pm).

If your child usually receives free school meals, a school packed lunch can be provided. However, your order will need to be placed (see slip below) by Tuesday 5th July.

If parents are attending, the children are more than welcome to eat their lunch with you. After lunch has been eaten, you may take your child home early. If you are unable to attend or cannot take your child home early from the venue, mini bus transport will be provided and the children will remain at school for usual home time arrangements.
